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PROPERTY OWNER NOTICE Citrus/Idaho Island

On **Monday, November 6, 2017, at 6:30 p.m.** the City of La Habra City Council will hold a meeting to consider the following items:

Consideration of resolutions requesting the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) approve the annexation of County Islands known as the Macy/Randall Island, Citrus/Idaho Island, Citrus/Entrada Island, Cypress/Terry Island, Hensel/Magda Island and Palm/Shadycrest Island to the City of La Habra and a Property Tax Exchange Agreement and Annexation, Dissolution of County Service Area #20 and transfer of Drainage Facilities between the City of La Habra and the County of Orange.

Our records show that you own property within the Citrus/Idaho Island. You are invited to attend the meeting and express your views about the proposed action. The meeting will be held in the City of La Habra, Council Chambers, at 100 East La Habra Boulevard.

This project was reviewed pursuant to the guidelines of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and determined to be Categorically Exempt pursuant to Section 15319, Class 19: "Annexation of Existing Facilities and Lots for Exempt Facilities" of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines as the areas to be annexed are developed to the density allowed by the current zoning of both the County of Orange and the City of La Habra.
